The charities in Dacorum regularly work together on various projects, and we have a very collaborative approach to tackling issues. It's these partnership workings that are truly unique in our community. Here are examples of some of the great work we do:

COMMUNITY ACTION DACORUM

Brings together businesses, charities, and other community organisations to make a difference to people in Hemel Hempstead and surrounding areas. Working with you, we make the area a fulfilling place to live and provide many support services to your staff and their families. One such service is our *Connect Dacorum* programme which provides opportunities for you fulfil your ESG / CSR aims as part of a vibrant local community.

Staying Connected is one of these programmes, where Connect Dacorum members donate redundant IT equipment such as laptops and tablets, which we then securely wipe, repurpose, and distribute out free of charge to those identified as in need.



DENS

DENS is not only the homeless charity for people in Dacorum, but we do so much more than just provide a roof and a bed. We are the first port of call for people in Dacorum who are facing homelessness, poverty and social exclusion. We support and empower them to take the next positive step, secure and maintain long-term housing, and be an active member of their community. We are so grateful for the amazing support we receive from local businesses. SUNNYSIDE RURAL TRUST

Sunnyside Rural Trust has worked in partnership with Dacorum Borough Council (DBC) and local partnerships from the voluntary and business sector to uplift Hemel Hempstead Old Town. This project demonstrates what can be achieved when these sectors work together using their collective skills and resources. We are a local charity supporting young people and adults with learning disabilities to find a place in the job market. Only 5% of all people with a learning disability in the UK are in any kind of paid employment. This is a disaster for the individuals at every level of their health, and living standards; it also creates a huge care bill for statutory funding and creates economic activity.
